Semester I

Semester III

Title of the course: - Sociological Theories. The course covers, Introduction to Sociological theories, August Comte, Ibn Khaldun, Karl Marx, Emile Durkheim and Max Weber, under six blocks.

Semester IV

Title of the course: - Method of Sociological Inquiry. The course covers, The Logic of Social Research, Modes of Sociological Inquiry, Methodological Perspective, Techniques of Data Collection, Sampling of data presentation and data analysis and report writing, under six blocks.

Semester V

Title of the course: - Marriage, Family and kinship. The outline of the course is; introduction, Descent and Alliance, Family and Household, Power and Discrimination in the Family, Choice and Regulation in the marriage in India and contemporary debates, under six blocks.

Semester VI

Title of the course: - Social Stratification. The course covers; Social Stratification: Concepts and Approaches, Caste, Class in India, Gendered Inequalities in India, Poverty and Social Exclusion, and Social Mobility, under six blocks.
