Your kind attention is invited towards our Circular letter of even number dated 21 May, 1998 through which we had requested all the Member Universities to accord recognition to the Degrees/Diplomas awarded by Maulana Azad National Urdu University, Hyderabad 500008 (AP).

We have been informed by the University Authorities that the Degrees awarded by them are not accepted by other Universities in the country. Since, Maulana Azad National Urdu University, Hyderabad, is a member of AlU, we once again request to kindly accept their Degrees on reciprocal basis in terms of the following AIU resolution:

"Resolved that the examinations of one university should be recognized by another on a reciprocal basis, provided that the entrance qualifications, duration of course and the general standard of attainment are similar to those prescribed by the recognizing university.

Further resolved that in case of degrees awarded by Open Universities, the conditions regarding entrance qualifications and duration of the course be relaxed provided that the general standard of attainment are similar to those prescribed by the recognizing university."

Subject: Equivalence of Degrees awarded by Open and Distance Learning (ODL) Institutions at par with Conventional Universities/Institutions

Sir/ Madam,

There are a number of Open and Distance Learning Institutions (ODLIs) in the country offering Degree/ Diploma/Certificate programmes through the mode of non formal education. These comprise Open Universities, Distance Education Institutions (either single mode or dual mode) of Central Universities, State Universities, Deemed to be Universities, Institutions of National Importance or any other Institution of Higher learning recognized by Central/State/Statutory Council/Societies registered under the Society Registration Act 1860.

2. A circular was earlier issued vide UGC letter F1 No- 52/2000(CPP-II) dated May 05, 2004 (copy enclosed) mentioning that Degrees/Diplomas / Certificates/ awarded by the Open Universities in conformity with the UGC notification of degrees be treated as equivalent to corresponding awards of the traditional Universities in the country.

3. Attention is also invited to UGC circular No F1-25/93(CPP-II) dated 28th. July 1993 (copy enclosed) for recognition of degrees and diplomas as well as transfer of credit for courses successfully completed by students between the two types of universities so that the mobility of students from Open University stream to traditional universities/ institutions is ensured without any difficulty.

4. The Government of India, in exercise of its power conferred under section 20(1) of UGC Act 1956, issued directions dated 29^{th} December 2012 entrusting UGC with the responsibility of regulating higher education programme in open and distance learning (ODL) mode. Consequently, Universities/ Institutions desirous of offering any programme through distance mode would require recognition of UGC.

5. As you are aware, the Government of India has envisaged a greater role for the Open and the Distance Education System. The envisioned role may be fulfilled by recognizing and treating the Degrees / Diplomas/ Certificates awarded through distance mode at par with the degrees obtained through the formal system of education. Open and Distance Education System in the country is contributing a lot in expansion of Higher Education and for achieving target of GER, without compromising on quality. Non recognition/ non equivalence of degrees of ODL institutions for the purpose of promotion/ employment and pursuing higher education may prove a deterrent to many learners and will ultimately defeat the purpose of Open and Distance Education.

6. Accordingly, the Degrees/ Diplomas/ Certificates awarded for programmes conducted by the ODL institutions, recognized by DEC (erstwhile) and UGC, in conformity with UGC Notification on specification of Degrees should be treated as equivalent to the corresponding awards of the Degree/Diploma/Certificate of the traditional Universities/ institutions in the country.

Sir/Madam,

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 26 read with clause (j) of Section 12 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956), the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017, had been notified in the Gazette of India on 23.06.2017. The first and the second amendment in the principal regulations were notified in the Gazette of India on 11.10.2017 and 06.02.2018 respectively.

2. Part-II; sub-regulations (3) to (5); of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 describes the Recognition process of Higher Educational Institutions for offering Open and Distance Learning programmes. The sub-regulations (3) describes the process of recognition of Higher Educational Institutions offering programmes in Open and Distance Learning Mode, whereas sub-regulations (4) describes the process for withdrawal of recognition and sub-regulations (5) provides right to appeal to Higher Educational Institutions aggrieved with the decision of the Commission.

3. The Commission had invited online applications from the eligible Higher Educational Institutions for offering Open and Distance Learning programmes from the academic session 2018-19 vide public notice F.No. 74-1/2018 (DEB-IV) dated 28.03.2018, mentioning therein that the online portal for submitting applications shall-be open from 2ndApril, 2018 to 1stMay, 2018. It was also mentioned that the duly certified hard copies of the application submitted online mode along with annexures shall reach UGC (DEB) office at 35 Feroze Shah Road, New Delhi-110001 within 10 working days of submission of online application. In response to the public notice dated 28.03.2018, **Maulana Azad National Urdu University** had submitted application online for programme wise recognition by the Commission.

4. Application received from Maulana Azad National Urdu University had been scrutinized by the expert committee and deficiency(s) or defect(s) in application were communicated and time period as prescribed in University Grants Commission (Open & Distance

Learning) Regulations, 2017 was given to remove or rectify such deficiency(s) or defect(s) with relevant documentary evidence.

5. **Maulana Azad National Urdu University** was invited for an Interface Meeting with the Expert Committee; constituted by the Chairman of the Commission; on **06**, **July**, **2018** in the UGC office, Bahadurshah Zafar Marg, New Delhi. The Expert Committee based on the application submitted, clarification given for deficiency(s) or defect(s)communicated earlier, the presentation made by the Higher Educational Institution in the Interface Meeting and in terms of provisions of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 and its amendments; made recommendations for consideration of the Commission.

6. The Commission in its 534th meeting held on 2nd August, 2018 considered the recommendations of the interface expert committee. Based on the decision of the Commission, I am directed to issue this Order, thereby communicating the programme wise recognition status of the programmes to be offered in Open and Distance Learning mode from academic year 2018-19 onwards by the Maulana Azad National Urdu University as detailed in point no. 7 below.

For the programmes recognized in 7(A) above, the Higher Educational Institution shall scrupulously abide in letter and spirit by all the terms and conditions, while offering the programmes in Open and Distance Learning mode, as per the provisions detailed in Part–III, Part–IV, Part–V, Part–VI and Annexure-I to Annexure-XI of the University Grants Commission (Open & Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017and its amendments. Some specific conditions given in UGC(ODL) Regulations, 2017 & its amendments are given in **Annexure 1**.

9. For the programmes found deficient in 7(B) above, the Higher Educational Institution shall submit representation along with documentary evidence, if any, within 30 days from the date of this order as per the provision at clause 4(i) of sub-regulation (3) of Part- II of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 and its amendments.

10. If the HEI fails to comply with the conditions of recognition or if it is found conducting affairs in a manner that leads to deterioration of academic standards, or if any information, documentary evidence submitted/produced by the HEI is found to be false or fake at a later date, UGC shall take action as per Regulation (4), Part. -II of UGC (ODL) Regulations 2017.



Non recognition/non equivalence of degrees of Open and Distance Learning (ODL) institutions for the purpose of promotion/employment and pursuing higher education may prove a deterrent to many aspiring students and will ultimately defeat the purpose of Open and Distance Education.

Accordingly, the Degrees/Diplomas/Certificates awarded for programmes conducted by the ODL institutions, recognized by the erstwhile DEC/UGC, in conformity with UGC Notification on Specification of Degrees should be treated as equivalent to the corresponding awards of the Degree/Diploma/ Certificate of the traditional Universities/Institutions in the country.

UGC has notified UGC (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 in the official Gazette on **23/06/2017**. As per UGC (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 under Part-I (2)(p), the programmes in engineering, medicine, dental, pharmacy, nursing, architecture, physiotherapy and such other programmes which require hands-on training are not permitted to be offered under Open and Distance Learning mode.

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1.0 About Maulana Azad National Urdu University

Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU) is a Central University, established by an Act of Parliament with all India jurisdiction in 1998. The headquarters and main campus of MANUU is in Gachibowli, Hyderabad. It is spread over 200 acres. MANUU is recognized as a major higher education service provider across the remote areas of the country for marginalized and first generation learners of Urdu medium through its regular and distance mode programs. MANUU commenced with distance education programs in 1998 and consolidated its academic and research base in Urdu medium regular programs in 2004.

The University is named after Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, a scholar par excellence, a prolific writer, an inimitable orator, a gallant freedom fighter, a visionary of the post independent Indian education system and an architect of technical and scientific education in Independent India.

Presently, MANUU is in the process of consolidating the existing institutions, while expanding it to reach the unreached through various intervention measures. 2.0 Directorate of Distance Education

The objectives of Directorate of Distance Education are:

- To integrate non-conventional Urdu learners with formal education system.
- To empower Urdu learners especially women by imparting quality education.
- To help learners acquire higher qualification for better career growth.
- To generate feeder group for the PG and research programs of MANUU on-campus mode.
- To enhance the gross enrolment ratio (GER) based on market needs, gaps and trends in addition to the societal demands.

The Directorate of Distance Education, MANUU operates through Regional and Sub Regional Centres located in 11-states of India. Each Regional/Sub Regional Centre (RC/SRC) provides academic and administrative support to distance learners through Learner Support Centres (LSC).

The Regional and Sub Regional Centres of Directorate of Distance Education facilitate the ODL students with support services, management of Study Centres and admission process. In the year 2017-2018, Directorate of Distance Education had 158 LSCs within the purview of its RCs/SRCs. In its endeavour to modernise itself and enhance quality for the benefit the ODL learners, DDE has introduced Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) framework for UG & new M.A. programs. DDE has vigorously started adopting ICT in its academic and administrative functioning. Admissions to all DDE programs are now being conducted through Online mode only. The University's Instructional Media Centre is preparing video lectures to provide anytime, anywhere learning environment to the learners through its dedicated IMC YouTube channel accessible at http://youtube.com/u/imcmanuu. A large repository of audio-visual educational programmes has already been prepared by the Media Centre and the work to even produce more is in process. Soft copies of SLM are also being provided to the learners through University's website. To improve communication between DDE and learners SMS facility is now extensively used to send alerts to students about various aspects of program delivery such as Course registration, Assignments etc.

The post graduation, graduation, diploma and certificates awarded by the University are at par with the certificates of recognized Universities. Day-by-day the strength of the students is growing. Thus, the DDE is striving hard to reach the unreached.

Admission to all programs offered by Directorate of Distance Education, Maulana Azad National Urdu University shall be made through Online Mode. The Admission portal can be accessed at <u>http://manuu.ac.in/admissions/odl2018</u>. Online applications must be submitted on or before Oct. 20, 2018. Following steps are to be followed for submitting the Admission Form:

• Register yourself at <u>http://manuucoe.in/DDEOnlineAdmission/index.php/main/registration</u>.

- This will generate a user name and password for the candidate which will be shared with the user through email/SMS.
- Login into the admission Portal at http://manuucoe.in/DDEOnlineAdmission/index.php.
- Enter data as per the format given in the form.
- Attach scanned copy of Proof of Studying Urdu Language as a Medium of instruction or as subject, wherever applicable.
- Attach scanned copy of date of birth proof. For example, X Class certificate or Aadhar Card.
- Attach scanned copy of proof of passing the qualifying examination.
- Attach scanned copy of your passport size photograph and signatures.
- Select Program you wish to apply for.
- Select program, Regional centre and Learner Support Centre. (Pl. note that you will be able to select/update LSC preference in 1st week of November, 2018)
- Pay Fee Online



The above will complete the form submission process. However, admission will be subject to verification of scanned documents at Regional Centres/Sub-Regional Centres. You may also be asked to produce original documents for verification at later stage. This shall be binding on you failing production of original documents or non-satisfaction of eligibility criteria may lead to cancellation of admission.

6.3.2 Diploma in Teach English:

Objectives of the Programme

Teach English, a one-year Diploma programme, is designed to help students and teachers of English to improve their proficiency (both spoken and written) in English and enable them to become quality teachers of English. The programme will be particularly useful to teachers of English in Urdu medium schools and colleges.

Eligibility: Any graduate or equivalent is eligible for admission.

Duration: The course is of one-year duration. However, it may be completed in two years.

Course Content: The Self Learning Material (SLM) is divided into four Courses, each of 20 units:

- I. Structure of Modern English I
- II. Structure of Modern English II
- III. Methods of Teaching
- IV. Classroom Techniques

Counselling and Support Services:

The study material will be dispatched to the student by post on confirmation of admission. No counselling classes are required. However, the students may contact the programme coordinator at Directorate of Distance Education, Headquarter (Hyderabad) through E-mail at <u>ssu.dde@manuu.edu.in</u> to clarify their doubts.

Scheme of Examination:

The Annual Examination consists of 4 papers each of 100 marks.



6.4 Certificate Programs



6.4.1 Certificate in Proficiency in Urdu Through English

Objectives of the Programme:

The main objective of this programme is to acquaint people with Urdu language. The programme has been so devised that persons who have basic knowledge of reading and writing English language will be able to learn Urdu. This programme will also be helpful to those who are closely associated with academic institutions like libraries, archives, academies and museums. It will open up avenues for low skilled technicians in film industry, T.V. and Radio.

Programme Content:

The programme consists of two papers of 100 marks each.

Paper - I :	Units 1 to 18 (Urdu Script, Basic Vocabulary)
Paper - II :	Units 19 to 28 (Basic Vocabulary, Grammar and Specimens of Prose & Poetry)

Duration of Programme:

The duration of the programme is six months. But the students, according to their convenience, can complete the programme within a maximum period of two years.

Admission Criteria:

The Candidate should be acquainted with English and should complete 18 years of age by 31st August of the admission year.

Counselling and Support Services:

Study material will be dispatched to the students by post on confirmation of admission. No counselling classes will be conducted. However, guidance will be provided by correspondence and e-mail. Candidate may contact the Programme Co-ordinator at Directorate of Distance Education, Headquarter (Hyderabad) through e-mail at <u>ssu.dde@manuu.edu.in</u> to clarify their doubts.

Scheme of Examination :

The Annual Examination consists of 2 papers each of 100 marks.

6.4.2 Functional English for Urdu Speakers

Introduction to Program:

The basic purpose of this program is to train urdu speakers to enhance their speaking and writing abilities in English language by improving their grammar, pronunciation etc. No counselling classes are organized in this program. However, SLM is provided to the learners.




